Annagry Graveyard Masses Cancelled: As the roadmap for re-opening society is now known in its general parameters, it has become clear that it will not be possible to gather as we would wish for our annual Graveyard Masses on Friday 24th July (New Graveyard) or on Sunday 26th July (Old Graveyard), in view of the numbers that gather and distances people travel to be present. We will have to consider whether this will be possible in a responsible manner later in the year.

This box will be emptied on a daily basis. The church is open daily from 11.30am-7pm.
