REOPENING ST MARY'S STAR OF THE SEA CHURCH TO CONGREGATIONS:

Over the last number of months people have sacrificed much in so many ways. We are very conscious that for many staying away from Mass was another sacrifice. Now that we have been given the date of June 29th to begin the process of getting back to have Masses with congregations present, there is much anticipation, enthusiasm and excitement, as well as anxiety and uncertainty.

The first thing we ask you for at this time is your patience as we navigate the guidelines and the methods we use in reopening our church. This will undoubtedly be difficult, and at times frustrating, but please stay with us as we work this out together.

For the Chapel to operate as per guidelines for the celebration of Masses, we will need volunteers in the area of cleaning. I want to thank those volunteers who came forward and continue to clean and sanitise the area at the back of the church so far, it is greatly appreciated. From 29th June more volunteers will be needed.

In Annagry we have calculated that a maximum of 32 individuals can sit in the main body of the chapel and a further 14 individuals in the gallery at a 2 metre social distance from one another. If there are individuals not of the same household each seat can only hold two people. However, if there are families of the same household, each seat can accommodate up to six people each. People will not be permitted to stand at the back of the church or on the gallery stairs.

We are looking at all avenues at how best to operate a system, including possibly booking your place in the church in advance. Another consideration is that families that have booked an anniversary Mass will be allocated a certain number of places, and this is how places may initially be allocated. All Masses are streamed on the webcam and this will help facilitate as many people as possible getting access to Mass.

As stated at the outset, there is still so much uncertainty as to how things will work out, and again ask for your patience and understanding, going forward. We will keep you informed at every step of the way as we go towards reopening with the best interests, health and safety of all our parishioners at heart. Please keep an eye on our parish website and Annagry Facebook page as the weeks go on. Sincere thanks again for all your understanding, co-operation and support to date.
