RETURN TO CONGREGATIONAL MASSES:

I am delighted to announce that from June 29th we have been given the go ahead to reopen St Mary's Star of the Sea Church for congregational Masses. We would ask at this time that those who are immune compromised continue to follow our Masses on the parish webcam for their own health and safety. We also understand that a lot of parishioners are not ready to come back to congregational Masses just yet. Children are welcome to attend Mass but it is vital that they sit with their parents at all times. Please continue to sanitise your hands every time you enter and leave the chapel.

At present, for churches the latest government guidelines permit an indoor gathering of a maximum of 50 people. If a family from one household comes to Mass, they can sit together. If there are two couples, they can sit at each end of a pew, otherwise the maximum number of individuals per pew will be two. You will be unable to stand at the back of the chapel or on the stairs.

As it stands there is no Sunday obligation, so we would ask you to only attend Mass once a week at this time, and to choose a day that suits you. Due to the limited capacity, unfortunately, there is a possibility that if you turn up to the church, the church may already be full and you will be unable to attend Mass.

If you are attending an anniversary Mass for a loved one, please contact me in advance and I will reserve a number of seats for the family. However, I would ask that you arrive at the chapel in good time before Mass.

You will be able to receive Holy Communion at this time but only in the hand. We ask you to remember social distancing guidelines when coming up for Communion.

There will be a collection every week, but we ask you to drop your contribution into the letterbox at the back of the chapel on your way in or out of the chapel.

There will be no choir or altar servers at present.

Baptisms, weddings and funerals can go ahead from this time with a limit of 50 people in total in the chapel and ensuring social distancing is observed at all times.

Confession can be heard after Mass again with social distancing being maintained.

We would ask that you ring the parochial house to book Masses, baptisms, etc and we ask that you do not come to the sacristy before or after Mass at this time.

We ask for your patience as we navigate these changes. What happens the first week may have to be altered for the following week, depending on circumstances. We do not know how this is going to work, so please bear with us as we take this step by step. We will not always get it right, and if anyone has any practical suggestions of how to do things better please share them with us.

We have a great team of volunteers who are sanitising the open area of the church each day. However, from Tuesday 30th we will need extra people to help to have the main church sanitised after each Mass. We are working on ways to minimise the amount of work involved so that it does not take too much time.
