Holy Communion to Sick and Housebound: House visits are not permitted under Covid restrictions, however If you would like to bring communion to someone who is currently housebound, isolating, or ill, please contact Fr. Nigel. Only family members who are living in the same house, or a person who is currently a carer and presently in constant contact with the person(s) may bring communion to those who would like to receive it. A person designated to bring communion may only bring it to one household, i.e. not to two or more people in different households.
