Lent 2021: On Ash Wednesday, we begin again our Lenten journey of renewal and conversion. On this day we traditionally had our foreheads marked with ashes in the sign of the Cross with the words: 'Dust you are and into dust you shall return' This year as we are unable to be marked by ashes in our churches, we offer this simple prayer resource to support families in prayer on Ash Wednesday at home. We pray that Lent 2021 will be a journey of renewal for families, for the community, and for the world. Pope Francis, reflecting on the ashes traditionally imposed on our foreheads at the start of Lent, said: "We are dust in the universe. Yet we are dust loved by God." The Holy Father added that we are precious dust that is destined for eternal life. He described Lent as a time of grace during which we can change our lives by letting God gaze upon us with love. This Ash Wednesday we need so badly to feel God's gaze of love in the midst of signs of suffering and death all around us as the pandemic continues to claim lives and livelihoods. As we begin our walk with Jesus to the cross and resurrection, we unite our mortality and limits to Christ's own suffering and passion in order that we might share his divine life. We know that Easter will come and that Christ is risen. We pray for God's grace this Lent to respond to his loving invitation, the call to repent. In returning to the Father, we experience the deep compassion of God that compels us too, to be compassionate to others.

Ash Wednesday Ashes: Our season of Lent 2021 begins this Ash Wednesday. As we are not able to come together to receive our Lenten Ashes due to Covid; from after 11am Mass, dried holy ashes in a sealed envelope, will be available at the back of the church. Each envelope contains enough blessed ashes for a household. To administer the blessed Lenten ashe, administer a few drops of holy water and make the sign of the cross on the forehead with the words: 'déan aithrí agus creid sa Soiscéa'l or 'repent and believe in the Gospel'.

Trocaire Lenten Prayer for Peace: As we begin our Lenten time, the time when we contemplate Jesus in the desert, pray for us the people of South Sudan and pray for peace there. Accompany us, hold our hands Lord and help those who hunger and thirst for your love and peace. Hold the hands of our brothers and sisters in South Sudan, help us walk with them during this Lenten time. We ask this through Christ our Lord, Amen.
