Return of Public attendance at Mass: In light of the latest Government Guidelines, the much welcomed news that churches with a limited capacity of 50, socially distanced, are permitted to open again from Monday 10th May. It is now mandatory that face-mask coverings must be worn in the church. If a family from one household comes to Mass, they can sit together. If there are two couples, they can sit at each end of a pew, otherwise the maximum number of individuals per pew will be two. You will be unable to stand at the back of the chapel or on the stairs. A huge thankyou to our dedicated volunteers who sanitize the church daily. If you would like to attend Mass, please consider going to one of the weekday Masses instead of a weekend Mass. First Holy Communion & Confirmation: Bishop Alan McGuckian has asked in light of the Taoiseach's announcement, that First Holy Communions and Confirmations be pushed back; therefore the Annagry First Holy Communion Mass which was due to take place on May 15th has now been postponed. The Confirmation Mass which was due to take place on May 29th has also been postponed.

RAPHOE DIOCESAN SOCIETY: We are encouraged to have our deceased relatives enrolled in the Society and we are encouraged to become living members. Any person wishing to become a member of the R.D.S. may apply to any of the Diocesan Clergy. (Membership fee is €15) An annual Diocesan Mass will be offered for the Raphoe Diocesan Society.
