

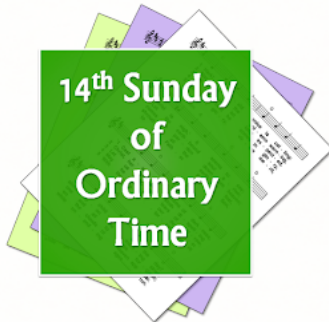

Mary's Meals: Mary's Meals are happy to announce the launch of their charity walk, Step by Step to Feed the Next Child.
