

Be guileless in friendship, astute in the face of deceit.

Be tough in times of ease, tender in hard times.

Be pleasant when things are unpleasant, and sorrowful when they are pleasant.

Disagree when necessary, but be in agreement about the truth.

Be slow to anger, swift to learn, slow also to speak, as St James says, equally swift to listen. Be gentle to the weak, firm to the stubborn, steadfast to the proud, humble to the lowly.'
