**Parish Garment of Suffering 2025:** Each of us at some stage in our lives experience trauma, loss, separation or bereavement. *Annagry Parish Pastoral Council* invites you these days of Lent to bring a little piece of cloth: @ 5 inches x 5 to the church altar to be part of Our Parish 'Garment of Suffering 2025'. This garment will symbolise our loss and traumas we have experienced in our lives. You are invited to bring little pieces of cloth, and place them in the basket at the foot of the altar. The cloth represents ourselves, or a family member, or friend, living or deceased. The little pieces of fabric will be gathered on the evening of Palm Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> April, and sewn together into one complete garment, a labour of love. During our Triduum and Easter services in Annagry 2025, we will pray to be healed. What is unique about this ritual is that you will be able to see and recognise your own piece of cloth, your own grief and suffering, loss, separation and bereavement and yet understand that so many others share similar worries. *'By His Wounds We are Healed.'*

**Upcoming Diocese of Raphoe Synodality Meetings:** Following on from the regional meetings that the Diocese of Raphoe held last year, a number of themes have emerged as being important for the Church in the future. Once again, the faithful are being asked their opinion in considering these topics and identifying which they feel are most important and which are less so. Two meetings are being organised in each of the three regions across the Diocese: **Ards Friary: Meeting 1 - 24<sup>th</sup> March at 7.00pm & Meeting 2 - 31<sup>st</sup> March at 7.00pm.** The purpose of the first meeting is to introduce the themes and give people time to think and pray about them. The purpose of the second meeting is to come to a consensus on which themes are the most important for the Irish Church. There is an open invitation to everyone to attend and participate in the future of the Church, and the future of the Diocese of Raphoe going forward.
