Parish Garment of Suffering 2026: Each of us at some stage in our lives experience trauma, loss, separation or bereavement. *Annagry Parish Pastoral Council* invites you these days of Lent to bring a little piece of cloth: @ 5 inches x 5 to the church altar to be part of Our Parish 'Garment of Suffering 2026'. This garment will symbolise our loss and traumas we have experienced in our lives. You are invited to bring little pieces of cloth, and place them in the basket at the foot of the altar. The cloth represents ourselves, or a family member, or friend, living or deceased. The little pieces of fabric will be gathered on the evening of Palm Sunday 29th March, and sewn together into one complete garment, a labour of love. During our Triduum and Easter services in Annagry 2026, we will pray to be healed. What is unique about this ritual is that you will be able to see and recognise your own piece of cloth, your own grief and suffering, loss, separation and bereavement and yet understand that so many others share similar worries. *'By His Wounds We are Healed.*
